

NaSTA 2012 Conference & Award – Code of Conduct

1. All delegates must accept the Code of Conduct before they will be eligible to attend the NaSTA Conference & Awards 2012
2. Both the individual and the station will be held jointly and severally liable for any damage or loss caused to University property (including accommodation and keys relating to accommodation).
3. Both the individual and the station will be held jointly and severally liable for extraordinary cleaning charges of University property as a result of their conduct (including accommodation).
4. The University of Nottingham and the University of Nottingham Students' Union reserve the right to remove anyone it deems necessary from its premises at any time for any reason.
5. It is the responsibility of the individual to ensure that the NaSTA Coordinator has been made fully aware of any disability, illness or other impairment that may affect the welfare of themselves.
6. Delegates must not breach the NaSTA discrimination policy and if do so may be asked to leave.
7. Delegates must comply with the instructions of the NaSTA Coordinator and University Security on all matters.
8. The University of Nottingham and the University of Nottingham Students' Union except no liability for personal injury.
9. Individuals will be sent an email confirming their ticket purchase and will receive a guest wrist band on arrival. Individuals must be able to produce one of these if requested by the NaSTA Coordinator or University Security.
